Registration Steps

- Step 1. Fill out the application form and sign the letter of declaration, then submit both to conniekoni@cc.ncue.edu.tw (Ms. Connie Chung)
- Step 2. Upon acceptance of an application by NCUE for 2017 NCUE SUMMER CAMP, a payment request will be sent to the applicant by email in 5 business days.
- Step 3. Make a payment by direct bank transfer to NCUE bank account in full in 7 days.
- Step 4. After making a payment, provide the receipt/ proof to NCUE (conniekoni@cc.ncue.edu.tw).

 Once the payment has been received, a letter of confirmation will be sent to the applicant by email in 5 business days.
- *Applications are NOT considered complete until the process has been fulfilled. You need to wait until receiving the confirmation email.

- The payment must be made in the full amount in USD, free of any deductions or withholdings, and without exercising any right of set-off.
- Please note that each bank will charge a handling fee for remittance, which should be paid by the applicants.
