

Da-Yeh University Regulation for International Students Scholarship

Amended at the 114 the Meeting of the Administrative

Committee on Mar. 15, 2018

Article 1 The Purpose of the scholarship is to facilitate academic exchange with the international community by attracting outstanding international students. DYU has promulgated the following regulations.

Article 2 The aforesaid “International students” shall mean students who do not possess the nationality of Republic of China (ROC) described by Article 2 of the Nationality Law and do not possess the identifies of overseas Chinese students or have lost ROC nationality for more than eight years.

Article 3 Application Requirements

1. Coming Students:

For those who apply for graduate programs earned a GPA of 3.0 or above (a 76% or above on a percentage scale) at previous university is required.

For those from non-native English-speaking countries with TOEIC 650 or TOEFL (IBT) 70 or TOEFL (CBT) 193 or TOEFL (ITP) 523 or TOEFL (PBT) 523 or IELTS 5 is required.

2. Continuing international students who have officially registered not received a written reprimand or more severe penalty from DYU as a result of misconduct, fulfilled one of the following criteria, and reach 80 of conduct performance are eligible to apply:

(1) Undergraduate students have completed a period of one semester of study and earned a 75% or above on a percentage scale as averaged or rank in the top 30% in the class from the previous semester. The competition and exhibition result will be calculated.

(2) Graduate students have completed a period of one semester of study and earned a 85% or above on a percentage scale as averaged from the last two registered semesters. The research result will be calculated.

Article 4 Application Materials:

1. Coming students:

(1) A copy of application form

(2) The original copy of official transcript of highest graduate school

(3) Chinese or English language proficiency

(4) A study plan or other reference documents

2. Continuing international students :

(1) Undergraduate students:

a. A copy of application form

b. The official transcripts of the previous two semesters

(2) Graduate students:

a. A copy of application form

b. The copy of official transcripts of the previous two semesters

c. List of Publications

d. A recommendation letter from Advisor

Article 5 Application schedule

1. Coming students should apply for the scholarship when submitting their application to DYU.
2. Continuing international students should apply for the scholarship to the Office of Foreign Affairs within one month after semester begins.

Article 6 Number of the Awardees

The number of awardees is dependent upon the fluctuation of the funds and adjusted accordingly by the DYU International Scholarship Committee.

Article 7 The members of DYU International Scholarship Committee are comprised of : Dean of the Office of Foreign Affairs, Dean of the Office of Research and Development, Dean of the Office of Student Affairs, Dean of the Office of Academic Affairs, Director of Accounting Office and the Deans of respective Colleges. Dean of the Office of International Affairs will be the convener and moderator of the committee meeting.

Article 8 Amount of the Scholarship

1. Class 1: Full - tuition fees and incidental fees for one semester and awarded additional NT\$ 40,000 (applicable to new Ph.D. students only).
2. Class 2: Full - tuition fees; incidental fees for one semester and awarded additional NT\$ 20,000 (applicable to new Ph.D. students only)
3. Class 3: Full - tuition fees and incidental fees for one semester. (applicable to all students)
4. Class 4: Half - tuition fees, incidental fees for one semester. (applicable to all students)
5. Class 5: Scholarship based on The International Students Scholarship Committee final decide of the Scholarship recipients.

Article 9 Overseas Youth Vocational Training School

International Students graduate from Overseas Youth Vocational Training School at DYU, may apply for degree program at DYU after the graduation. The scholarship will be decided by the grades in Overseas Youth Vocational Training School at DYU. Students who ranked top 5 in class may receive Class 3 scholarship, and the rest may apply for Class 4 scholarship. Students who don't graduate from DYU, may apply in the application period and receive Class 4 scholarship.

Article 10 Period for Receiving the Scholarship

1. One semester which Fall semester starts from September of a year to January of the following year, Spring semester starts from February of a year to July. Scholarship will be issued before midterm.
2. The maximum scholarship duration of each degree program is as follows:
Undergraduate program: maximum 4 years accumulatively (3 years for transfer student). Master's program: maximum 2 years accumulatively. Doctoral program: maximum 3 years accumulatively. The tuition, miscellaneous and dormitory fees is exempted for the fourth year Ph.D. program student.

- Article 11 Students (above 4 people) who are recommended by Da-Yeh University's sister partner High School or International Education Institution (which must be authenticated by a Taiwan's overseas representative office), and enroll at DYU the coming semester are awarded of "Recommendation Scholarship". Students are awarded additional NT\$ 10,000 for the first semester, maximum for eight semesters. Starts from the second semester, students shall award the same if they follow the requirements of Article 3.
- Article 12 Students, those are recommended by DYU sister schools and approved by the Office of Foreign Affairs as of poor families with excellent academic performance, might be awarded Class4 scholarship for the first semester.
- Article 13 The Scholarship Evaluation
1. The Office of Foreign Affairs will first review the applicant base on their application documents.
 2. The Department will rank their applicants base on their academic and research performance. Later, after being approved by the Dean of the department, the ranked list of candidates and application materials will be delivered to the DYU International Scholarship Committee.
 3. The International Scholarship Committee will finally decide the scholarship recipients.
- Article 14 The application regulations and scholarship for coming students and present students are regarding to Article 3 and Article 8. The International Scholarship Committee may have the final decision of the scholarship due to applicant's performance.
- Article 15 The Scholarship Evaluation Criteria
- The International Scholarship Committee will finally decide the scholarship recipients due to the budget.
- Article 16 The scholarships which sponsor by the enterprises, DYU will provide the list of the candidates for the reviewing process of enterprises.
- Article 17 Students who have already received grants from other institutes are not eligible for DYU scholarships. If the amount of grants are below the scholarship at DYU, students may also apply for scholarship due to The International Scholarship Committee decision.
- Article 18 Termination of the Scholarship
- The scholarship should be terminated immediately after awardees' suspension, withdrawal or graduation from studies. If any untrue was to be found in a scholarship recipient, the award will then be terminated and the recipient should return the total sum of scholarship given.
- Article 19 Should a scholarship holder be discovered to have inferior academic performance during the award year, the award will be terminated with written consent of the advisor, and the dean of the college. The award will be terminated in the following month.

Article 20 This scholarship policy should be review and adjusted accordingly. Any matters insufficiently provided for herein should be subject to the laws and regulations concerned.

Article 21 What is left unmentioned may follow DYU or Ministry of Education related regulation.

Article 22 This regulation comes into effect upon the approval of the Administrative Committee. Amendments to this guideline will follow the same procedure.
