### How to combine searches

- Select the checkbox to the left of the record you would like to combine.
- START will appear next to the first item you are combining and a dialog box will appear at the bottom of the search history page.
- Choose the next record to combine and choose a Boolean operator to combine the searches.
   Common operators are: AND, OR, NOT. The dialog box will automatically update to reflect your combined query.
- Click COMBINE when you have finished building your combined query.

- Date range refinements need to be reapplied when searches are combined.
- Any refinements applied will be merged when combined.
- Saved search alerts are not available for combined searches.
